Present: Don German, Ray Wiggs, Cherie Mittenthal, Dawn Walsh and Brian O'Malley. A quorum was declared.

Francine D'Olympio has resigned from the Council after years of service.

Public Present: Bob Daniels, Tony Fuccillo of Provincetown Tourism Office.

Minutes of Sept. 11 were reviewed. The MCC funding will be \$4500, and the PCC account has about \$7000, with corrections by Chair. Approved on motion by Mittenthal.

Annual Report was reviewed. Account balance may not reflect requests from last years' grants.

AIDS Memorial update: An early November minor surface correction is planned. The artist has not been fully paid, as the copyright held by the artist will need to be assigned to the Town. A marker has been planned; Mittenthal will contact the Town. The hedge is to be trimmed shorter along Ryder St. to not obstruct view, Wiggs will check with DPW.

Mr. Fuccillo reported on Cultural District designation by the Mass Cultural Council last May. The goal is to improve marketing and promotion for Town. A map is being compiled, locating cultural sites and galleries, and will eventually exist on Tourism site. Guidance is sought from the PCC. Signage will be consistent with MCC standards; we will be given four, and can purchase more. We will meet Nov. 14 to provide guidance.

Art Marketing guidelines are discussed. Wiggs has developed a draft proposal which was discussed; a forum of stakeholders is considered. No decision made.

Grant applications are due 10/15, and will all be available online.
