The Provincetown Conservation Commission will hold a Public Hearing at 6:30 p.m. on **Tuesday, March 19, 2019** in the AUDITORIUM, Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, MA to consider the following requests:

CON-18-089 **151A Commercial Street**

Request to Amend Order of Conditions (DEP File No. SE 058-0595) filed by Joseph Smith and Scott A. Popkowski, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, to change the western alignment of the previously-approved vinyl sheetpile wall. Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, Coastal Beach, and Buffer Zone to Coastal Beach.

CON-19-059 **74 Atkins Mayo Road**

Local Bylaw Filing by Trudy Wood, pursuant to the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for a septic system upgrade to include pumping and filing or removal of existing leach area, trenching and excavating for proposed leach field and pump chamber. Work to take place within Buffer Zone to Isolated Vegetated Wetland.

CON-19-060 **3 Heathers Way**

Local Bylaw Filing by Robert Sheehan, pursuant to the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for limited excavation and construction of timber steps and retaining walls to provide basement access. Work to take place within Buffer Zone to Isolated Vegetated Wetland.

CON-19-061 **8D Commercial Street, Unit A**

Notice of Intent filed by Joanne Cancro, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, to lift existing dwelling, pour flood-compliant foundation, and add deck with stairs for access. Work to take place within Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands.
