Special Liquor License

Petition from Kathleen Weiner representing **Outer Cape Health Services**, for **Special Liquor License** for an event to be held on August 25, 2018 from 3:00pm to 7:00pm at 9 Ryder St. Ext. No rain date requested

No one presented.

FT made a motion to approve as presented. SB seconded the motion and it passed, 4-0-0; FT, SB, ZL, RC.

Special Entertainment License

Petition from Rick Murray, representing **Crown & Anchor, Inc.** for **Special Entertainment Licenses** for events to be held on August 19, and September 2, 2018 from 12:00pm to 2:00pm at 243 Commercial St. No rain dates requested.

Rick Murray presented; passed around copies of his entertainment license for Sundays which he said he's held for 18 years; said he had gotten a notice from Building Commissioner Annie Howard that he was in violation of his license by operating drag brunches which he said he didn't understand as he thought the inn-holder's license he currently holds is for the whole of the property and its usage, including entertainment and alcohol, from the street to the high water mark on the beach; said he doesn't use amplification and didn't want to go through Zoning and pay for lawyers in appeal.

FT said he agreed with Rick Murray that the inn-holder's license was all-inclusive.

No public comments or letters.

ZL made a motion to approve as presented. RC seconded the motion and it passed, 4-0-0. ZL, RC, FT, SB.

Special Entertainment License

Petition from Elizabeth Gawron, representing *Helping Our Women* (HOW), for a **Special Entertainment License** for an event on August 17, 2018 from 12:00pm to 2:00pm at 328 Commercial St. No rain date requested.

Elizabeth Gawron, Executive Director of HOW and Ann McGuire, HOW board member, presented; submitted abutters letters in support.

FT noted the event had been going on for several years.

ZL made a motion to approve as presented. RC seconded the motion and it passed, 4-0-0; ZL, RC, FT, SB.

New Annual Wine & Malt Package Store and Common Victualer Licenses

Petition from Joseph Freitas, representing *141 Bradford Natural Market, LLC* for a **New Annual Wine & Malt Package Store License & New Common Victualer License** at 141 Bradford St., Provincetown.

Joe Freitas, co-owner, presented; said they only want to sell beer and wine and would focus on local makers and sustainable, organic wine brands that are in keeping with the Market's purview.

FT said the Town had two more malt/liquor package stores than it is supposed to have legally and that if the applicant had come before the board for more liquor, they wouldn't have been able to grant it.

No public comments or letters.

SB made a motion to approve as presented. RC seconded the motion and it passed, 4-0-0; SB, RC, FT, ZL.

Special Entertainment License

Petition from Ken Abert, representing *Provincetown Tennessee Williams Festival* for a **Special Entertainment License** for events to be held on September 26 from 7:00pm to 10:00pm; September 27 from 7:00pm to 11:00pm; September 28 from 12:00am to 10:00pm; September 29 from 12:00pm to 11:00pm; and September 30 from 12:00pm to 8 pm, 2018 at 9 Ryder St. Ext. No rain date requested.

Ken Alpert presented, passed around documents; said this is their third year presenting at the Whorf building on the Pier and that there would be one play performed and no alcohol served.

Petition from Amanda Brabec, representing *Cape Air* for a *Special Liquor License* for an event to be held on August 24, 2018 from 9:30am to 2:00pm at The Provincetown Airport. No rain date requested.

Amanda Brabec presented; said the event is a tame, close-of-the-summer, customer appreciation day with Mimosas served by a bartender from Strangers and Saints, and donuts from The Donut Experiment; an event to greet customers as they come and go and thank them for another season, get them excited about the Town and showcase a couple of local businesses.

RC made a motion to approve as presented. SB seconded the motion and it passed, 4-0-0; RC, SB, FT, ZL.

Special Liquor License

Petition from Kathleen Weiner representing *Outer Cape Health Services*, for *Special Liquor License* for an event to be held on August 25, 2018 from 3:00pm to 7:00pm at 9 Ryder St. Ext. No rain date requested.

Tony Valentino from Around Town Events representing Outer Cape Health Services; said it's the annual Lobster Fest fundraiser, completely sold out with 180 guests, that it's been going on since at least 2012; wine and beer served by certified bartenders.
