Notice of Intent filed by Siobhan Carew, Trustee, Nathaniel Hopkins Condominium Trust at Union Wharf, pursuant to the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. c. 131, s. 40) and the Provincetown General Bylaws Chapter 12, Wetlands Protection Bylaw, for permanent structural repairs, including installation of 15 helical piles, for support under and within the existing building (Sal's Restaurant). Work to take place within Land Subject to Coastal Storm Flowage, Coastal Beach, and Buffer Zone to Coastal Beach.
