Fire House #2:

Chris Mathieson stated that it would be easy to convert the upstairs into an apartment. There would be a storage issue for the town as we currently use it for storage. It is a great space. Michelle Jarusiewicz spoke about the previous effort to create apartments there which got stuck by accessibility issue. Chris Mathieson said that it could be sold and rented privately with the money going to the Trust. It could be sold and conditioned that must be year-round use for some number of years. With the consideration of offering accessible unit elsewhere, Tom Donegan suggested converting the office or laundry room at Harbor Hill.

VFW:

Could look at VFW site as potential 40B development and increase the density.
