

RREC Minutes
August 4, 2021

Tom call to order 10:01 a.m.

Present: Tom Jung, Sue Jungi, Elise Cozzi, Chris Mathieson; Staff: Sherry Prada

Tom moves to approve minutes from June 9, 2021 and July 7, 2021 as presented. Sue 2nd
Roll call vote 4-0-0.

Tom: Aaron at licensing has sent letters to plastic bag offenders. As for the upcoming plastic water bottle ban, cartons will not recycle. Move to glass or cans.

RREC has an open position if anyone knows of a like-minded person.

Stickers for storm drains and sidewalk buttlers: Elise move to spend not more than \$300 of our budget. Tom 2nd. Roll call vote 4-0-0

EV stations: Chris- since we are a green community there may be a grant of \$7,500. We need to advocate for EV stations. Tom will speak to Erin Ellis. State has a 3% adoption rate. Taking Ferry vs driving has a 60% reduction in Green House Gases (GHG)

Tom and Chris discussed Facebook and Instagram account for getting info out there.

Sherry said we can pay for advertising with budget.

Elise said maybe we could use The Independent, WOMR, for "Did you know..." thoughts on what is recycled etc.

Chris-comprehensive coordinated to reach as many people as possible...we have \$900 budget.

Tom will reach out to Jay G on the VSB map for water bottle filling stations, etc.

Town Hall water bottle filling station...Sherry will check for lobby.

Sherry-MSW charts will be sent...will photo cardboard baler for advertising

Coastal Resiliency Committee: for climate mitigation and adaptation. Replenish and rebuild beach to prevent flooding at Ryder Street, Reduce GHG etc. Chris wants to add "climate" to our mission statement on web site.

Elise moves to have Chris on Committee Tom 2nd. Roll call vote 3-0-1.
