

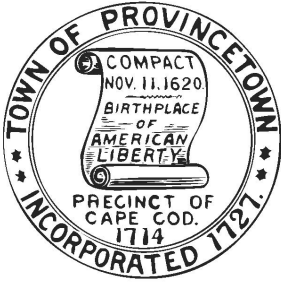
Meeting Agenda
