

**Recycling & Renewable Energy Committee Minutes**

- Tom called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Roll call vote unanimous
- Elise moved on approval of minutes September 15, 2021. Sue second. Roll call vote unanimous
- Elise and Tom to review meeting minutes with Ted Jones 09/11/2020 to make sure they reflect our vote on the water bottle ban.
- Open position: RREC is still looking for one member; posted on Facebook.
- Storm drain stickers. Supplier cannot get product. We will reapply for grand with CARE when they become available.
- Sherry: DPW received \$5,000 for cardboard; \$4,000 last month. Continue to encourage people to take it to the transfer station. Mattresses at \$20 each may be going up soon. Foreman at transfer station retired so there is a vacant spot.
- Budget available is \$9,700, \$250 for education, \$1,000 for flyers.
- Water bottle filling station/hand washing station/bubbler for new East End Waterfront Park: After discussion, Tom move to approve quote without foot washing station and with a plaque Approximate cost \$5860.35 Elise seconded; roll call vote unanimous.
- Printing Budget: Recycling Rules makes refrigerator magnets and countertop signs to educated visitors on recycling while in Provincetown. Elise move to investigate price. Sue seconded. Roll call vote 4-0-1 with Tom recuse himself
- Social media outreach is ongoing
- Lydia: Butt buttlers need stickers. When supplier gets product we will order them.
- Elise proposed store owners sweeping daily in front of their stores. She will check Beautification and Board of Health.

- Chris: discussion on climate change and mitigation to follow our purview. Town is investigating how to combine climate change, resilience and adaptation. Tom attended Outer Cape Climate Committee whose focus is electric vehicles, greenhouse gas emissions and solar. Tom will introduce Chris to the committee.
- Lydia: recycle stickers should be on town barrels
