Mr. Burrows was under the impression that the police details were scheduled from a meeting he had with the Police Chief back in April, which was emailed to the Licensing Agent. However, it turned out that the last step in completing the scheduling never took place, nor was he aware that an additional step needed to be done. Richard McMasters stated that it was negligence on the Police Department for not communicating, or scheduling it with the applicant at the first meeting they had to do a follow up. Hunter O'Hanian stated that once the conditions are in place it is the job of the applicant to fulfill them and make sure they are met. It is not the responsibility of Town officials, or employees to do it.
