Rate Increase Hearing

Rex McKinsey suggested that the PPPC have a meeting in October for the rate increases. In answer to Martin Michaelson's question of in what time frame this needs to occur, George Hitchcock told the Board that the PPPC needs to do this as soon as possible so that the fishermen can plan. He also said that the PPPC should send a letter of notification out that the rates will change.

Rex McKinsey suggested that the Board plan to hold the Public Hearing on the 6th of November.

The next PPPC Board meeting was scheduled for October 18th at 3pm.

Revised Harbor Regulations

Rex McKinsey distributed copies of the proposed revisions to the Harbor Regulations. Joyce Guide asked Members to review the document to discuss at the next meeting.

Pushcarts

Robin Haueter told the Board that a focus group looking into the pushcart issue for the Town has come up with the idea, in lieu of allowing pushcarts on the Pier, of having a fleamarket on the Pier on Fridays, perhaps being extended into Saturdays and Sundays, which is being viewed by the focus group as a way of bringing in revenue. Robin Haueter spoke in opposition to the plan.

Amendment 13 Letters

Robin Haueter presented the draft of a letter regarding Amendment 13, and told the Board that the shared letter between the Town, Profish and the PPPC has to be handled immediately.

Martin Michaelson said that he favored the idea of sending in the PPPC's own letter and signing the shared letter, while

submitting comments to Lawyer Henchy on the contents of the shared letter.

Meeting was adjourned at 4:38pm.
