The group discussed draft regulations of the Pier Corp.

Mr. Bergman presented the position of the Mass. Attorney General: Town Meeting can approve a warrant to allow town to enforce any Pier Corp. regulations in place at the time of the Town Meeting, in this case April 7, 2004. A warrant to create a town by-law to allow town enforcement including non-criminal disposition of Pier Corp. regulations has been filed.

Mr. Bergman also explained that future changes to Pier. Corp. regulations that require town enforcement will have to be approved by future Town Meetings. Pier Corp. regulations or policies that do not require town enforcement for non-criminal disposition, such as the setting of rates and fees, are unaffected. The following example was given: a vessel that hasn't paid dockage fees is subject to the criminal offence of trespass.

Mr. Bergman said that eventually town will want an operational services agreement between Pier Corp. and town that designates town employees as agents of Pier Corp. and allows for compensation for services town provides to Pier Corp.

Mr. Bergman left the meeting and the remaining group reviewed and revised the draft regulations.
