Michael made a motion that a memo stating that grant holders provided photocopy of propagation license (possession only license) should be submitted with yearly grant fee. Motion was made by Michael on Frank and Tony suggestion that 10 new signs that read "No shellfishing violators will be prosecuted" should be placed on the grants. Motion was seconded by Sarah. **Motion carried** unanimously.
