DFP is seeking a 50% reduction in the fee for the rental fee. The discussion centered on why the placement of the ferry ticket booth in relation to the Pavilion is a hardship for DFP. As a result of the new configuration, unanticipated costs were incurred. Extra time had to be spent by David and Kiki to redesign the event, including the flow of patrons, extra staff will need to be hired, a tent rented and counsel consulted.

A motion was made to approve the application by Ruff Studio for an arts and crafts event on July 11, 2010, contingent upon approval of samples of the arts and crafts to be sold and the incorporation of the Trap Shed contract clause stating: "Lessee shall not sell, distribute or display any item or provide any service in any manner which, in the good faith judgment of the Town and its successors and assigns, is inconsistent with the quality of operation of the Pier or may tend to injure or detract from the moral character or image of the Pier within the community; and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Lessee shall not permit any nudity in the premises and shall not sell, distribute or display any paraphernalia commonly used in the use or ingestion of illicit drugs, or any x-rated, pornographic newspaper, book, magazine, film, picture, video tape, video disk, or other similar representation or merchandise of any kind clause regarding appropriate subject matter", into the Pavilion application.
