Public Hearings

New Annual All Alcohol Restaurant License

1. Petition for a new ***Annual All Alcohol Restaurant License*** from Rubarb, Inc., Viola D. Briseno, mgr. d.b.a. ***Chach***, 73 Shank Painter Rd., Provincetown, MA. Robin Reid, Esq. speaks on behalf of licensee, Viola D. Briseno. Zoning Board of Appeals approved. One speaker in favor, and one letter in support.

New Seasonal All Alcohol Package Store

2. Petition from Gary Pasnick, representing ***East End Market Place*** for a ***New Seasonal All Alcohol Package Store License*** at 212 Bradford St., Provincetown, MA. Gary Pasnick states that any remaining liquor will either be returned to the liquor company or stored. Liquor will be kept in the aisle, facing the register. Nine letters in support. Penny Silva speaks in opposition of the application and believes it should have been re-advertised. David Gardner states that town council recommends re-noticing. Marcene Marcoux speaks in favor of the Licensing Board voting and approving the application. Two others speak favor of moving ahead with the application. One other speaker in opposition. Comments and discussion from the Licensing Board.
