New Seasonal All Alcohol Hotel License – Continued from April 10, 2012 meeting

1. Petition from Clifford Hagberg, representing ***Sandcastle Resort and Club*** for a ***New Seasonal All Alcohol Hotel License*** at 929 Commercial St., Provincetown, MA.

Linda Ersoy and Clifford Hagberg distribute handout with floor plan showing area of service, menu, and serving sizes. Gates are around the pool area to prevent patrons from leaving licensed premises with alcohol. Arranging for TIPS training. Display of cups for non-alcoholic beverages and alcoholic beverages.
