Proposed Alteration of the Public Way

Article 7. Alteration of Layout of Route 6.

Description of Proposed Change: This article will alter the layout of Route 6. Currently the land where the leaching field and Jerome Smith Parking lot are located is partly Town-owned land and partly on the Route 6 Right-of-way, which the Town also owns. While no longer required for the construction of a police station at the site, this action will clean up the lot lines so that the parking lot and sewer structures are located wholly within the parcel.

Recommendation: On June 20, 2019, the Planning Board voted 4-0-0 to recommend approval of Warrant Article 7.
