



Public Notice

On **Thursday, October 17, 2019**, the **Provincetown Board of Health** held a **Public Hearing** on proposed changes to the **Board of Health Regulations**. The changes to the regulation are underlined and in bold below:

1000. SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING

1010. SUBPART A: SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

1015. REQUIREMENT TO LABEL SOLID WASTE RECEPTACLES

All solid waste receptacles in Provincetown, whether holding recycling or solid waste, shall be labeled with the corresponding property address on two (2) sides of the receptacle. This requirement applies to residential and commercial solid waste. This regulation will go into effect on December 01, 2019.

Approved by the Board of Health by a vote of 4-0-0, effective upon posting.

And:

PART VI, ARTICLE 8 – Nuisance Regulations

Section 6. ABATEMENT OF NUISANCE

To mitigate the nuisance conditions posed by dumpsters or disposal containers, all property owners, contractors, businesses, or other entities utilizing a dumpster or disposal container shall contract with an Integrated Pest Management professional for the entirety of the time that the dumpster or disposal container is used. The Integrated Pest Management professional shall utilize proactive pest management practices that limit the use of anticoagulants as a method of pest management.

Approved by the Board of Health by a vote of 4-0-0, effective upon posting.
