





# of ambulances out of service



- **LARGE ATTRACTIONS**
- **SHARED BATHROOMS IN ACCOMMODATIONS (EXCEPT FOR GROUPS WHO SHELTERED TOGETHER)**
- **FOOD BUFFETS OR DRINK SELF SERVICE (INCLUDING COFFEE)**

# Activities that Cannot Occur Safely

**SUMMER 2020**

---

- **LICENSED OUTDOOR  
SMOKING AREAS OF  
RESTAURANTS AND BARS**
- **CRUISE SHIPS & BUS  
TOURS**
- **PUBLIC OR SEMI-PUBLIC  
SHOWERS, SAUNAS, OR  
STEAM ROOMS**  

Examples: gyms, marinas, and campgrounds
- **STREET PERFORMERS/  
BUSKING**

# Pending Operation Guidelines

**WE WILL WAIT FOR GUIDELINES FROM THE STATE ON SAFE OPERATION OF:**

- Restaurant table service (take-out/delivery is allowed)
- Bars / nightclubs
- Public pools / hot tubs
- Hair salons, massage, body art
- Gyms / yoga studios
- Childcare / recreational camps
- Lodging establishments
