To either of the Constables of the Town of Provincetown, Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and in the manner prescribed in the Charter and By-laws of said Town, you are hereby directed to notify the inhabitants of the Town qualified by law to vote in Town affairs to meet and assemble on **Tuesday, May 11, 2021** in the Auditorium of Provincetown Town Hall, 260 Commercial Street, Provincetown, Massachusetts 02657 between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. to vote to elect the following officers on the Annual Town Election ballot:

- One Moderator for a term of three years;
- One Select Board member for a term of three years;
- Two School Committee members for terms of three years;
- Two Library Trustees for terms of three years;
- One Charter Compliance member for a term of three years;
- One Charter Compliance member for a term of one year;
- One Housing Authority member for a term of five years;

Ballot Question 1

Shall the Town of Provincetown be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to pay costs of implementing elements of the Town's Storm Water Improvements Program, and for the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?

Ballot Question 2

Shall the Town of Provincetown be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to pay costs of interior and exterior repairs to Town Buildings pursuant to the Building Capital Plan, and for the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?

Ballot Question 3

Shall the Town of Provincetown be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds to be issued in order to pay costs of implementing the Court Street drainage and repair project, and for the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?

Ballot Question 4

Shall the Town of Provincetown be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds to be issued in order to pay costs of

the Ryder Street outfall storm water project, and for the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?

Ballot Question 5

Shall the Town of Provincetown be allowed to assess an additional \$136,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for the purpose of creation of the Office of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021?
