Pier Maintenance Tech /Operational Staff Job Description

Supervision:

Works under the direction of the Pier Manager/Facilities Manager on long-term and short-term operational, mechanical, infrastructural and maintenance related projects. This position may require supervision of junior tech/operational staff as needed.

Overview:

Moderate physical labor and knowledge of basic mechanical and carpentry skills are required. Housing is not included.

Duties:

Flexibility is required for the variety of work related to repair, maintenance and infrastructure improvement projects. The following duties may be required:

- Providing general maintenance servicing and seasonal duties related to the following: jib cranes, ice machine, marine patrol vessels, electrical pedestals, heat trace units, roadway and industrial lighting, pilings and piling caps, town-owned gangways and floats, canvas awnings and signage.
- Painting and keeping equipment in good repair.
- Carrying out special projects as assigned.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or GED (additional marine education is desired).
- Valid MA driver's license and good driving record.
- CPR and First Aid certifications.
- Good physical condition and clean public appearance (moderate physical effort required under all weather extremes).
- Forklift operation and certification a plus but not required.
- Sound decision-making and problem-solving skills.
- Knowledge of basic mechanical and carpentry skills.
- Good moral character.
- Ability to swim (general lifesaving skills desired).
- Completion of a thorough and extensive background investigation.
