Position Opening

Non-Union – Deputy Harbormaster

The Town of Provincetown is now accepting applications for the seasonal position Deputy Harbormaster with the Provincetown Harbormaster Department. This seasonal position is typically 40 hours per week April through October and part-time November through March.

Deputy Harbormaster: This position is second in command in the Harbormaster Department and acts as Harbormaster in the absence of the full-time Harbormaster. Duties include enforcing local, state and federal boating laws; safety operations on MacMillan Pier; supervising seasonal part-time Assistant Harbormasters, is supervised by and reports to the Harbormaster; is expected to be on stand-by or on-call 24 hours a day to assist with emergency operations in Provincetown Harbor; and be physically able to perform all related duties to the job that includes fulfilling the Harbormaster's responsibilities relative to the Town of Provincetown's Marine Services Agreement with the Provincetown Public Pier Corporation.

Minimal Qualifications: The Deputy Harbormaster must be knowledgeable of Provincetown Harbor Regulations; have a general knowledge of MGL 90B and the Department of Homeland Security Facility Security operations and Rules for Preventing Collisions at sea; possess such character as to represent the Town of Provincetown in a positive manner at all times; possess basic knowledge of small craft operations and maneuvering; possess a valid vehicle drivers license; and, pass a criminal background check.

This is a Grade T, non-union position with an initial training pay of \$25.10 an hour. The position is available immediately and will remain open until filled.
